Covid 19 - Update

Our government advised that all staff and workers who may have contact with students in schools throughout the country (regardless of COVID-19 Alert Level) will be required to have a first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by 15 November and be fully vaccinated by 1 January 2022. From 1 January 2022, education services must only allow those that are fully vaccinated to provide onsite services during opening hours.

- This means vaccinations are mandatory for all those working onsite including teachers, relief teachers, casual staff, administration staff, caretakers, cleaners, etc. It also applies to unpaid workers, such as volunteers (including parent volunteers) and any members of the community who are on site at the school, as they are likely to come into contact with students.
- Parents taking students on field trips will need to prove their vaccination status.
- Parents and caregivers irrespective of vaccination status are still able to attend meetings or school events.
